MEET DRIFTING WINES

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Black currants, raspberry and dark cherry flavors find themselves soaring amongst the toasted oak that produce this smooth and flavorful wine.

CHARDONNAY

Tropical notes waft into flavors of lightly toasted oak, green apples and surprise you with a zest of light lemon finishing rich and carefree.

OLD VINE ZINFANDEL

Sweet cherry, blueberry and light plum aromas and flavors lift your senses and are completed with a black pepper spice and slight tobacco that end in a full and silky finish.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Zesty citrus and green apples collide with fresh peaches and a touch of passion fruit. The finish is lingering and complete with a slight fresh acidity.
